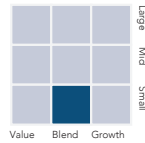

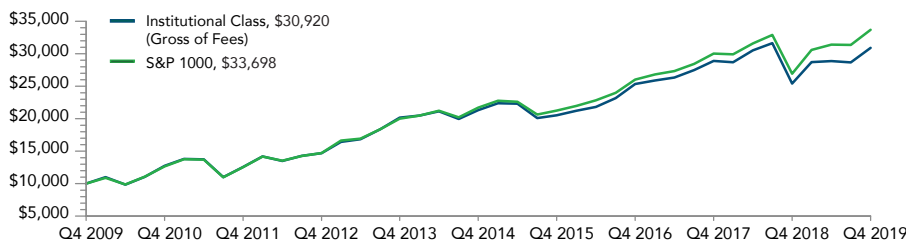

## Investment Process

The Fund employs a six-step process that combines small-mid cap style allocation with relative risk controlled portfolio construction and values screening policies.

## Values-Based Screening Methodology

The Fund applies a proprietary set of values screens to all of the investments. Screens applied to the portfolio management process allows investors to avoid owning securities in companies that choose to profit from businesses that are at odds with values-based investing.

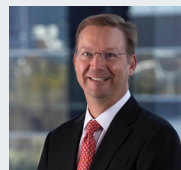

The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star. The Overall Morningstar Rating for a managed product is derived from a weighted average of the performance figures associated with its three-, five-, and 10-year (if applicable) Morningstar Rating metrics.

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
